WHEREAS, amateur radio provides excellent volunteer communications for agencies including the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, Illinois Department of Public Health, National Weather Service, the American Red Cross, the Salvation Army, Central Illinois Earthquake Consortium, and others in times of natural disaster and other emergencies; and,

WHEREAS, Illinois has more than 20,000 amateur radio operators who repeatedly donate time, equipment, and services to help their communities; and,

WHEREAS, by continuous learning and experimentation, amateur radio operators help to forward the science of electronics and radio-related communications; and,

WHEREAS, Illinois radio amateurs will continue to hone their communications skills by operating during the national simulated emergency preparedness exercise known as "Field Day" June 25 - 26, 2022;

THEREFORE, I, JB Pritzker, Governor of the State of Illinois, do hereby proclaim June 2022 as Amateur Radio Month in Illinois.
